Analysis Report:


- All students and 99% of parents reported that they feel safe at school.
- All parents also reported that their children have friends at school, and 99% reported their children have at least one positive relationship with an adult at school.
- An area for growth based on the survey results is timely feedback of student progress and expectations for learning. The elementary staff has been working for the past year and a half to revise the report card for better explanation of grade level expectations in reading and math. We will continue to work on strategies to keep parents informed of student progress throughout the year as well.

Ranking of Priorities:

Families were also able to indicate their top priorities to provide a quality education for all students. Here are the top five:

- #1 Recruit and retain high quality staff
- #2 Develop new and innovative programs to improve student learning

Ionization System

Thank you to the School Board for approving the purchase of a product called the GPS Ionization System this fall to improve the air quality in our buildings. It is a system used by many hospitals and a few school systems to eliminate bacteria and viruses, in many cases at a 99% effectiveness rate. In addition, it improves air quality and controls odors.

Although the system was purchased in response to COVID, it will improve air quality long-term, which is extremely important, especially with the number of inside classrooms.

Anecdotally, some have noticed their seasonal allergy symptoms have been less at school this fall as well.

Thank you, again, to our school board for being proactive to help keep us as healthy as possible at school.
